## Works in the rail corridor in November

We're removing four dangerous and congested level crossings at Coburns, Exford, Ferris roads in Melton, and Hopkins Road in Truganina to make Melton boom gate free in 2026. We're also building a new modern and accessible Melton Station.

## What we're doing

We'll be working over the coming months to establish our construction sites, relocate underground services and install fencing in the rail corridor.

During these works, there will be rail, pedestrian and car park impacts in your area.

24/7 works	<ul> <li>From 10pm, Friday 8 November to 4am, Monday 11 November, crews will work 24 hours a day to complete low impact works along the Ballarat, Ararat and Maryborough line.</li> <li>Impacted residents and stakeholders will be notified directly.</li> </ul>			
Pedestrian	<ul> <li>There will be a pedestrian detour in place at Ferris Road at times until late 2024 to allow for underground services to be relocated.</li> <li>Please see the pedestrian detour map overleaf.</li> </ul>			
P Melton Station car parks	• To prepare for construction, a number of car spaces at Melton Station will permanently close in late October and November. Please see Melton Station precinct map overleaf.			

## What to expect

- Minor traffic delays on Exford, Coburns and Ferris roads, while vehicles access the rail corridor.
- An increase in noise and traffic movement throughout the day. .
- Traffic management including lane closures and reduced speed limits at times.
- Permanent closure of some car parks at Melton Station.
- Works taking place 24 hours a day while coaches replace trains on the Ballarat, Ararat and Maryborough lines.








## Ferris Road – pedestrian detour map
