

Player Contract

Being selected for a SACCSS Team is both a privilege and a commitment.

It requires you to maintain a commitment to your studies and the team you have been selected for.

As a player you need to complete all work from classes you miss when out at sport. This will require you to have open communication with your teachers.

If there are circumstances where you cannot complete your class requirements because of being out at sport, the privilege to attend will be revoked.

In order to participate in SACCSS Team events, it is expected that you will behave in a manner that is consistent with the school's core values at all times.

This includes observing all rules, safety procedures and teacher directions as required, refraining from all forms of bullying, harassment, racial vilification and discrimination, refraining from disruptive behaviour, respecting school property and dressing in accordance with the school's uniform requirements.

Unacceptable behaviour may result in your removal from the activity and/or SACCSS Team as deemed appropriate given the nature of behaviour displayed.

To attend SACCSS sport you must agree to the above information by signing this contract as well as receive permission from your House Leader and a final sign off from Sports Coordinator, Miss Alp.
