# Cost inclusions

**Cost:** Approximately \$8,000 – there are a number of calculations to complete as we make bookings. AUD fluctuates against the EUR until we lock in the booking.

# SFCC Policy – Overseas Travel with Students

One of the main criteria for overseas trips and immersions, which are auspiced by the school, is that families have the financial capacity to ensure all deposits and scheduled payments for the immersion experience are made in a timely manner for their young person to attend

- One would assume if a family could make that contribution, then they would be up to date with their school fees.

Process for students interested in travelling on SFCC Overseas trips

- Once an initial list of students interested is drawn up, those names are emailed to the Finance Office, which will determine who is eligible to proceed in the selection process.
- The second part of the process will be started once the school is satisfied that families have the capacity to pay their school fees firstly and secondly, their contribution to the overseas travel.
- A student's behaviour at school will also be considered in the selection process.



# Payment schedule

1. Deposit - \$500
2. 2<sup>nd</sup> of September 2024 - \$1,000
3. 1<sup>st</sup> of November 2024 - \$1,500
4. 4<sup>th</sup> of April 2025 - \$1,500
5. 6<sup>th</sup> of June 2025 - \$1,500
6. 31<sup>st</sup> August 2025 - remainder (approx. \$2,000)
